



Document Manager Technical Specifications

Retrieval of a 50 page image document across a 10Mbps network should take 10-15 seconds during normal working hours

Document Manager Database Server

- **Document Manager hardware requirements vary depending on the size and nature of the deployment.**
- **Document Manager can manage thousands of users.**
- **The following are examples of recommended current hardware for up to 200 users.**
 - **10 Document Manager users**, maximum 250,000 documents managed by Document Manager. Windows 2003 server, Dual Core Xeon 1.6 GHz with 1Gb RAM, Microsoft SQL Server 2000 or 2005 with appropriate number of client licenses.
 - **50 Document Manager users**, 50,000 documents created per month. Windows 2003 Server, Dual Core Xeon 2GHz with 2Gb RAM, Microsoft SQL Server 2000 or 2005 with appropriate number of client licenses.
 - **200 Document Manager users**, 250,000 documents created per month. Windows 2003 Server, Quad Core Xeon 2Ghz with 4Gb RAM, Microsoft SQL Server 2000 or 2005 with per server or CPU licenses.

Remote Control Software and dial in access are required if Infonic or the Document Manager Partner is to provide remote access support. Disk space required depends upon system components' configuration, document storage and cache configuration.

The Document Manager SQL Database Server specifications provided are recommendations only and should always be checked by a qualified Document Manager Engineer. If additional functions are required such as Document Manager Indexer, Web, etc., the specifications will need to be adjusted.

- Windows 2000/XP/Vista: P4/Core 2 Duo or faster, 256MB RAM minimum (512MB for XP), (1Gb for Vista) 15" SVGA monitor or better.
- Document Manager systems that use SQL server database licenses require SQL client licenses.
- Thin Client - Web: PC capable of running Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.5SP2 or later.
- Thin Client - Citrix / Terminal Services: Please refer to recommendations published by Citrix or Microsoft.



Scanner Options

- Twain compatible and Kofax Adrenaline driven scanners.
- A suitable SCSI adaptor, Kofax Adrenaline card or Kofax VRS via USB port is required for each scanner installation. Adaptec SCSI PCI and Kofax Adrenaline cards or AIPE recommended.
- Recommended scanners include: Fujitsu, Kodak, Panasonic, Canon, Hewlett-Packard, Bell & Howell, Konica Minolta & Toshiba MFDs.

Printer & Electronic Fax options

- Windows compatible printers.
- Windows compatible electronic fax software.

Supported electronic fax solutions include: Castelle FaxPress, WinFax PRO and RightFax.

Document Storage & Recovery options

- Assume 50KB per Letter size monochrome document side.
- To calculate storage overheads = ((Number of Letter size document sides stored a month x 50) / 1024) = MB each month / 1024 = GB each month.

Assume 20,000 Letter size pages will require 1GB

Local & Wide Area Network options

- Document Manager is network and protocol independent and is scalable from an office LAN to a global WAN.
- Networking between Sorting Office Index Station/s and the Server/s should use 100Mbps switches not unmanaged hubs as the network load imposed by transferring large numbers of files can be substantial.
- Networking between the Server and User Stations.

Retrieval of a 50 page image document across a 10Mbps network should take 10-15 seconds during typical working hours. This estimate can be affected by local network topology.
